LifeLong Learning Wednesday Mornings -Students participating in LLL classes should enter the building through the front door and sign in at the front desk.

Free Student Supervision on Wednesday Mornings - To access this option, parents need to drop off students at the cafeteria door outside the primary playground. If parking, please utilize the SAC Parking spots in the Back Parking Lot. Parents must be present to check-in students - students may not walk and check-in themselves. Please contact the Office if you have any questions.

Chromebook Return - We are trying to recover the Chromebooks sent home with students at the end of last year. Please bring the chromebook for your current 1-5 grade student or your incoming 6th grader to Bear Creek or send it with your student.

School Supplies - Bear Creek elects to buy school supplies in bulk, as opposed to sending out a list of required supplies, which saves our families money and time. **Fees** - this year Bear Creek will ask for a \$75 donation - \$50 for school supplies and \$25 for technology. Technology supports device maintenance, acquiring new devices, and licenses for technology tools used by students. You can pay these fees through RevTrac. Here is a tutorial on the use of RevTrac for those parents who are not familiar with it.

BCE T-shirts - All kindergarten students and those students new in grades 1st - 5th will receive a free Bear Creek t-shirt **next week**. These t-shirts are used for spirit days and field trips. Parking Lot Reminders - please remember a couple simple rules for the use of our Parking Lot at drop-off/pick-up:

- The loop is used as a "Hug and Go" lane. Parents should never leave cars unattended in the loop. Additionally, whenever able, please pull forward as far as possible to ensure other cars are able to access the parking lot.
- Never park on the crosswalk, and always be aware of pedestrians.
- If you need to park, please utilize one of the parking spots.
- The front parking lot is for community usage. The back parking lot is for staff usage. The only community members who should be utilizing the back parking lot are parents who are dropping-off/picking-up students from SAC, and community members accessing our Electronic Vehicle Charging Station.
